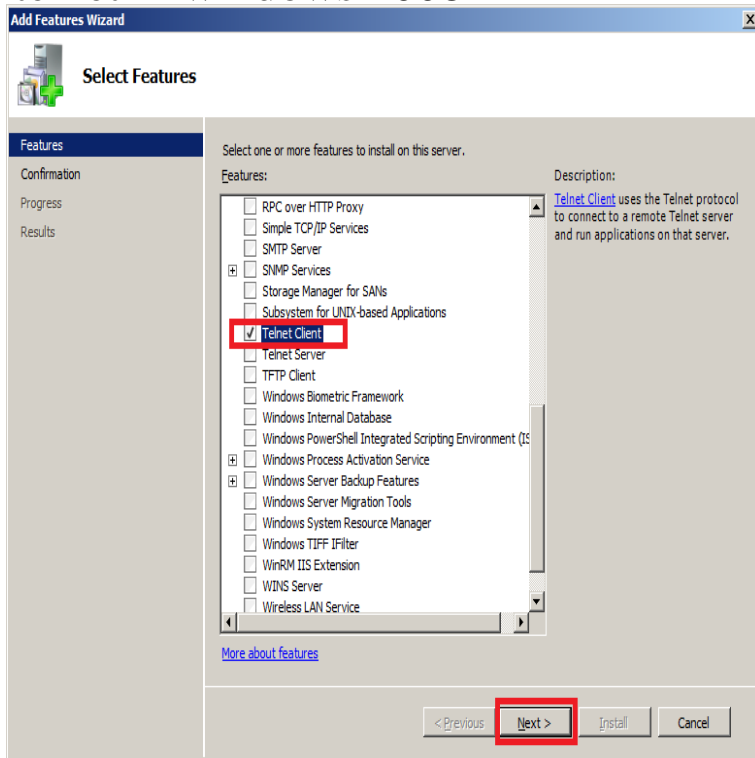


# telnet in windows 2008
